

Essay guidelines

If you find yourself eligible to apply for the Bright Future Scholarship, you are required to write an essay (900 to 1100 words). The central question to answer in your essay: “As an impactful innovator, how would you contribute to creating a better world with your obtained degree?”

Please ensure that you adhere to the guidelines below while writing your essay:

- The essay must be written in English if you apply for an English programme or in Dutch if you apply for a Dutch programme.
- Make sure it is a personal essay and not a motivational letter or cv.
- It should be based on a personal experience in which you have gained significant insight, or which resulted in personal growth or development.
- It is written in the first person. (“I” point-of-view).
- In your essay try to give us a glimpse into your own perspective.
- Be specific with your descriptions.
- Be authentic and honest.
- The simplest structure of an essay has three parts: an introduction, a body of information, and a conclusion.
