Why do we organize The Hague Matching Days?

Thank you for registering with a study programme at The Hague University of Applied Sciences. We would like to invite you to The Hague Matching Days.

The aim of this activity is to give you a good idea of the content and the level of the programme. You will also meet some future lecturers and fellow students. At the end of the day you will have an evaluation. We call this the Study Choice Check. After this you can decide if this is the right programme for you.

Preparatory Assignment

As you will be aware, as a result of a referendum held in June 2016, the United Kingdom (UK) has decided to leave the European Union (EU): "Brexit". Though the UK has officially notified its wish to withdraw from the EU on 29th March 2017 and almost three years have passed since the referendum, at the time of the drafting of this assignment the withdrawal has still not been effected.

Write a one-page (A4) essay in which you briefly summarize:

1. Why the majority of the UK electorate has voted for leaving the EU in the referendum;
2. Which rules apply to the 'divorce proceedings': the way the UK and the EU are supposed to effect the UK's withdrawal;
3. What has happened since the referendum;
4. Why the withdrawal still has not been effected;
5. What is likely to happen in the next few months in order to establish the withdrawal as yet.

Finish your essay with your own brief assessment/opinion.

Please make sure to pay due attention to the structure of your essay: title – introduction – main part – finish/conclusion, using paragraphs for distinguishable parts. Use proper English. Add your name to the document. Save it as <your surname – assignment Brexit – Matching Day LAW>.

How do I hand in the assignment?

Upload the assignment as pdf document in Osiris. Please write down your name and student number on it. You can log in to [Osiris Registration](#). When you signed up in Studielink, you have received an e-mail with your student number, your log in information and the link to Osiris Registration.

After logging in you can see the programme(s) you are enrolled for. Select The Hague Matching Days 2019 for the programme you want to hand in the assignment and click 'further'. Answer the questions on the screen, upload the assignment and send it in. You will receive a confirmation automatically by e-mail.
